Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to a new term, I do hope that you had a wonderful Easter break and were able to unwind and have some quality family time! Summer promises to be very busy as we have a lot of ground to cover as well as exciting trips to attend, more information and dates will come soon! Please take the time to read this letter and make a note of key dates.

Our Topics:

History and Geography: Our topic this term is 'It's All Greek To Me' and we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and their influence on us and the world.

Art: We will be developing our understanding of sculptures and 3D abstract shapes.

DT: We will have the opportunity to make some Greek dishes. Closer to the time, we will ask for your help with ingredients.

Science: Our science topics this term are Amazing Bodies: Exercise and Nutrition and Forces and Magnets.

Other learning this term:

English: This term our work will be inspired by How To Live Forever by Colin Thompson, The Mysteries of Harris Burdick by Chris Van Allsberg and Our Tower by Joseph Coelho.

Maths: We will be learning to identify, represent, compare, add and subtract fractions and then we will move onto exploring parallel and perpendicular line and time.

PSHE: This term we will be learning to overcome obstacles, how to be inclusive and cope with rejection. We will also learn about how to stay safe, money management, the impacts of smoking and basic First Aid.

RSHE: We will learn about different forms of help and support.

RE: We will be exploring God's rules for living, New Commandments and Buddhism.

PE: Our Wednesday PE lessons will be dance and the Friday lesson will be led by a SG Sports coach.

Computing: We will be developing our knowledge of data, how to sort it in graphs and explore simulations.

French: The focus for the term is to be able to recognize, recall and spell different instruments French, as well as follow the story of Little red Riding Hood in French, recalling key vocabulary and phrases.

Music: To play melodic and non-melodic percussion and singing. Perform actions confidently and in time to a range of action songs.



Home Learning:

Weekly homework will be set on PurpleMash, on a Wednesday and should be submitted on or before the following Tuesday. Homework will consist of a mathematical task, spelling activity and a reading comprehension. Weekly spelling tests will take place on a Tuesday. Please encourage your child to read for 10-15 minutes every day. If you would like to deepen your home learning, please refer to suggestions at the bottom of the page

English

Read books from the local library or complete other reading comprehensions on SerialMash.

Use your writing journal to create your own story using the skills we have learnt this year.

Maths

Recap number bonds to 100 and the place value of each digit.

Recap multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 times table.

Identifying, classifying and making fractions.
